**Summary:** This position is responsible for working with the Youth Program Manager in the delivery of preventative health education including dental health education to youth in various community sites. All functions and activities will be guided by Esperança's Strategic plan, policies, mission, goals, and vision.

**Primary Roles & Responsibilities**

- Develop, schedule, and deliver health education to promote optimal wellness by following established best practices for wellness
- Establish and maintain partnerships with relevant organization and individuals, with an emphasis on providing on-site services in schools or community centers
- Accurately identify/assess youth and their family's needs to connect them effectively to resources that will support the whole family meet their basic needs
- Develop and maintain a comprehensive list of available community partners and resources (employment, education, social service agencies, etc.) for youth and their families and collaborate with fellow public health organizations focused on oral health initiatives
- Manage metrics and evaluate outcomes of regularly scheduled on-site programs and services as required and facilitate pre/post program surveys and recommend improvements
- Collects stories from participants in the community on the effectiveness of the preventative health education workshops and their personal experience

- Experience working with youth and youth development education
- Aware of low-income communities within the greater Phoenix area
